Perfect as a first project, this pretty little dress uses the classic colours of pink, white and blue with tiny touches of green. It is smocked with a simple design that uses only wave and cable stitches. Dainty roses decorate the lower edge of the smocking and lace trims the edges of the smocked sleeves. The neck is finished with binding and the dress closes down the back with white buttons.
